AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND WATER ORDINANCE 061109
CHAPTER 00, ARTICLE I, SECTION vi & vii WATER RATES

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Byron, Rock Island County, Illinois, that the following amendment be made to Water Ordinance 021908, Chapter 00, Article 1 (Water Service Charges), Section vi (Rates) and vii (non-metered residential users).

- vi) Rates. A minimum of \$27.00 monthly shall be applied to all users whose water consumption does not exceed 2,500 gallons monthly. Usage in excess of 2,500 gallons monthly will be charged at a rate of \$2.50 per 500 gallons.
- vii) All non-metered residential users of the water facilities shall pay a flat rate charge of \$27.00 monthly. The flat rate charge will allow a maximum of 2,500 gallons monthly. In the event use of the water facilities is determined by the VILLAGE OF PORT BYRON to be in excess of 2,500 gallons monthly, the VILLAGE OF PORT BYRON will require such flat rate user to install metering devices on the water supply to measure the amount of service supplied.

Rates effective starting with March 1, 2008 billing cycle.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed, in so far as they do so conflict.

If any provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such paragraph, clause, or provisions shall not affect any of the other provision of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication thereof, as provided by law.
